If You do not agree to the terms of this Agreement, do not install, access or use the Software.

The Software is protected by copyright laws and international treaties. Unauthorized use, duplication or distribution of this program or any portion of it without the express written consent of StrongBox is strictly prohibited. ALL RIGHTS RESERVED.

"Modshield SB" is a trademark of StrongBox IT LLC. Any other trademarks are for identification purposes only and are the property of their respective owners.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. DEFINITIONS

"Modshield SB means the ModShield SB virtual / physical appliance / instance, a web application firewall, underlying Modsecurity engine, OWASP CRS and StrongBox IT proprietary content. Modsecurity and OWASP CRS are open source components distributed under Apache License 2.0 found at (https://www.apache.org/licenses/LICENSE-2.0). Certain implementations might use the GeoLite2 database from Maxmind (https://www.maxmind.com)

"Derivative Works" means a revision, enhancement, modification, translation, abridgment, condensation or expansion of Software or any other form in which such Software may be recast, transferred or adapted, which, if used without the consent of StrongBox, would constitute a copyright infringement.

"**Documentation**" means the user manuals and any other materials in any form or medium made generally available by StrongBox to You, regarding the proper installation and use of the Software.

"License" means a license granted by StrongBox to You that allows You to use the Software in strict accordance with this Agreement.

"Software" means the Modshield SB WAF (as defined herein), the Documentation, and all third-party software that StrongBox may have purchased or licensed from third parties and delivered to the You as part of the Software.

"**Term**" means the period of time StrongBox grants the License to You under the terms and conditions of this Agreement as further specified in Section 3A.

2. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

A. **Ownership**. Title to the Software, Documentation, and all patents, copyrights, trade secrets and other worldwide proprietary and intellectual property rights in or related thereto are and will remain the exclusive property of StrongBox and its licensors except the components distributed using Apache 2.0 and MIT Licenses. You may not remove any titles, trademarks or trade names, copyright notices, legends, or other proprietary markings in or on the Software or Documentation and will not acquire any rights in the Software or Documentation, except the limited license specified in this Agreement. StrongBox and its licensors own all rights in any copy, translation, modification, adaptation or Derivative





Works of the Software, including any improvement or development thereof. StrongBox retains all rights not expressly granted to You in this Agreement. You shall promptly notify StrongBox in writing upon discovery of any unauthorized use of the Software or Documentation or infringement of StrongBox's proprietary rights in the Software or Documentation.

- B. **Open Source Components**. Modshield uses Modsecurity and OWASP CRS which are components provided to You under Apache License 2.0 found at (https://www.apache.org/licenses/LICENSE-2.0). It also uses sb-admin-2 as a frontend template. The base template is MIT licensed but the customizations on the UI are proprietary content of StrongBox
- . This software includes certain third-party software as set out in the Documentation, which may be updated from time to time in line with new versions of the Open Source Modsecurity Software, and which may be used only in accordance with the licenses set forth therein. The Modsecurity Software, and the OWASP CRS rule sets, are open source as set forth in the Documentation, and may be used only in accordance with the licenses set forth therein, which prevail over the terms of this Agreement with respect to such third-party software. Source code for these components is available upon written request to Modsecurity and on their respective websites. With respect to Modshield SB, third-party components are integrated by StrongBox for and on behalf of You in accordance with the Agreement. Therefore, any third-party software delivered to You pursuant to this Agreement, including any third-party's plug-in that may be provided with Modshield SB, is included for use at Your option, solely in accordance with the corresponding third-party software license(s). Modshield SB shall have no liability for Your use of any third-party software.

3. LICENSE GRANT

A. **Software License**. You are granted a non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-assignable, non-sublicensable, restricted license during the term set forth in this Agreement, to install and use one copy of the Software in accordance with the relevant Documentation. The Software and Documentation may not be distributed to any third parties.

The license granted herein is subject to the specific restrictions and limitations set forth herein, the terms of the open source licenses governing the components included in the Software, and/or any additional licensing restrictions and limitations specified in the Documentation, or by notification and/or policy change posted at www.strongboxit.com.

You may use the Software for internal business purposes only in relation to its own computer systems. You may not use the Software for providing hosted or service bureau services to the general public or any third-party entities.

B. Restrictions on Use. Subject to the terms of the open source licenses governing the open source components referred to in Section 2(B), You shall not (i) allow third parties or develop methods for third parties to use the Software; (ii) sell, rent, lease, use collectively, record, license, sublicense, share, distribute, publicly communicate, transfer or exploit in any other manner the Software or Documentation, unless otherwise expressly provided for in this Agreement; (iii) except as provided by applicable law, decompile, disassemble, or reverse engineer the Software, in whole or in part, and You shall not attempt to obtain in any other manner any Software source code, and shall not carry out any action to the detriment of StrongBox's intellectual property rights or those of its suppliers; (iv) make copies, execute,

Such audit shall be conducted during regular business hours at Your offices and data centers and in such manner so as not to unreasonably interfere with Your normal business activities. In no event shall audits be conducted more frequently than once every six (6) months. The audit shall be conducted at StrongBox's expense; provided, however, that if the audit reveals that You have failed to comply with any material term of this Agreement, You shall pay all reasonable costs and expenses incurred by StrongBox in conducting the audit, and any applicable unpaid fees.

You may use confidential information solely in accordance with this Agreement and will take all reasonable precautions necessary to safeguard the confidentiality of such information. You will hold in confidence and not disclose, reproduce, distribute or transmit the confidential information, directly or indirectly, in any form, by any means, or for any purpose, except to those of its employees, agents, consultants or subcontractors who require access for Your authorized use of the Software in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. You will implement reasonable security measures to protect such confidential information at a level no less restrictive than used to protect its own confidential information.

L. 107-56, signed into law October 26, 2001), as amended; and restrictions against dealings with certain prohibited, debarred, denied or specially designated entities or individuals under statutes, regulations, orders, and decrees of various agencies of the United States Government. 9. TERM AND TERMINATION





This Agreement and the licenses granted hereunder shall remain in effect for the period specified in the Agreement, unless earlier terminated as set forth herein.

YOUR RIGHT TO USE THE SOFTWARE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FROM THE DATE YOU FIRST INSTALL ANY PORTION OF THE SOFTWARE ON ANY DEVICE AND SHALL CONTINUE FOR THE SUBSCRIBED PERIOD, AT THE END OF WHICH TIME YOUR RIGHTS SHALL CEASE. NOTICE OF EXPIRATION MIGHT NOT BE GIVEN, SO YOU NEED TO PLAN FOR THE EXPIRATION DATE AND MAKE A COPY OF AND REMOVE YOUR IMPORTANT DATA BEFORE EXPIRATION. You hereby irrevocably consent to jurisdiction of courts located in Sheridan, Wyoming. The effective date is the date Modshield SB is downloaded / installed by You.
